## **Healsafe Toilet Paper Holder**


**Installation Guide** 

The toilet paper holder is designed to be suicide and self harm resistant. Therefore it is important to follow this mounting description.

- The bracket should be mounted with two safety screws with a flat bottom head. The diameter of the screw head should be from 9.5 to 10 mm to fit the countersunk hole.
- The diameter of the screw threaded portion shall not exceed 5mm, this is the diameter of the holes. C-C between the holes is 40 mm.
- Make sure the screws have been pulled all the way to the bottom of the countersunk part.
- The installation should be done so that the bracket fits snug to the surface it is mounted to. Uneven surfaces must be avoided.
  - Check that no objects, rope or string can be inserted between the bracket and the wall.
- Note that the bracket should be mounted with the short end of the clamp up. Follow the instructions on the back of the bracket.

- The toilet paper holder shall not be mounted along the same horizontal line as an object with a supportive surface such as a cabinet, sink, door, shelf, etc., that is closer than 30 cm. See example 1
- When mounting two or more holders on the same wall the mounting description in illustration 2, 3 and 4 should be followed. When installing two paper holders on the same wall they should be mounted in a vertical or diagonal line of least 30 centimetres between the toilet paper holders.
  - -See example 2 and 3
- The paper holder shall not be mounted along the same horizontal line.
  - -See example 4
